Period : from August 4 (Fri) to August 25 (Fri)

Accommodation : Richard's House, a Doshisha University's dormitory of international exchange, to be opened in April 2006, a single-room with bath and toilet

Program fee : ¥180,000- (tentative)

Rent fee : ¥35,000- (tentative)
