

Industry / Labor Theme and Generations: Difference Between industries of "the richness"

<Summary>

This paper performs comparison between industries about a factor to describe "the richness" of an employee. As the result of analysis, following four points became clear. The first, a negative correlation was found between income and working hours by the analysis of economic richness (annual income) and space of life time (annual total actual hours worked). The rich earns short working hours. The second, there are different phenomena among industries for both in effect of education and business scale effect. Third, in an industry, the income of major education group pulls minor group. This phenomena a (Major attractor) dominates the business scale effect. The fourth, effect of education and business scale effect are different in each generation. As the result factors for each industries and generations.
